How to look after Apple Vision Pro

The Apple Vision Pro headset is a great piece of technology, but it is very expensive and easily broken if not handled correctly.

The person who loans the headset is responsible for its safety and paying for any damage.

Please read this guide on how to avoid common causes of damage:

1. Do not wear glasses while using the Apple Vision Pro

This will scratch the headset's lenses.

2. Do not lift the headset using the grey light seal

It is only held magnetically, and you will drop the headset.

Hold it by the metal and glass frame at the front.

3. Take caution when moving from sitting to standing or moving about

Ensuring the battery pack is not in your pocket or left on the table.

This could pull the headset off your head or the table.

4. Do not try to change the Apple ID associated with the device

This could prevent other people from using it.

5. Sign out of your personal accounts before returning the headset

Sign out of any apps or websites in Safari before returning the headset.

This is to prevent a risk to your personal data.

Who can access the Apple Vision Pro headsets?

The headsets are available to the following groups only:

1. Current UAL Diploma Apple Development students
2. Previous UAL Diploma Apple Development students
3. CCI PhD students.
4. CCI staff.

Other students are not permitted access due to the need to prioritise these for the above groups.
